Homelessness	The school provides Project Upstart questionaires in registration packet and they are sent home via backpackstwice during the school year to current students; the counselor is then provided the questionnaires once completed to reach out to parents in need; the counselor then assists parents with completing applications and referrals for assistance.			
Cultural Differences	To improve parent engagement and overcome language and cultural barriers among Spanish- and Haitian Creole-speaking families, the school will provide interpreters for all meetings and translate key materials such as newsletters and notices. Monthly "Family Connection Meetings" will be held with breakout sessions in each language, offering childcare and flexible scheduling to encourage attendance.
